

- The title must not exceed 120 characters.
- The abstract should not exceed a maximum of 300 words.
- Incorporate a maximum of 5 keywords.
- The abstract must be sent in the language in which the communication or poster will be written (Spanish, Portuguese or English).
- Example of an abstract with the required format.
- Please indicate your preference for an oral or poster presentation when prompted by MF.
